COURSE PROGRAMME

WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

In this topic-based, interactive Advanced Beginners course you will build on your basic grammar skills and increase your vocabulary to improve the ability to express yourself more fluently in familiar, everyday situations.

Week 1: Express preferences, likes, dislikes and give reasons

modal verbs (part I), sub-ordinate clause using *weil*

Week 2: Talk about past events

split verbs, conversational past tense (part I)

Week 3: Talk about past experiences

conversational past tense (part II)

Week 4: Provide personal information (context: job interview)

modal verbs (part II)

Week 5: Describe and rate cities

prepositions of place

Week 6: Express and justify your opinion

subordinate clause using *dass*

Week 7: Talk about art and describing paintings

2-way prepositions

Week 8: Ask for and provide advice (context: shopping)

demonstrative pronouns

Week 9: Discuss habits and routines (context: shopping)

connectors in main and sub-ordinate clauses

Week 10: Provide and follow instructions

imperative mood

Week 11: Describe emotions and feelings

personal pronouns in the *Dativ*

Week 12: Customs and traditions

revision of grammar structures
