Who is the course for?

This class is suitable for students with elementary German language skills, which is equivalent to the first level (A1) of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Level A1 means that you can use familiar, everyday expressions and very simple sentences.

What will you learn?

This conversation course aims to give you an insight into how German speakers discuss everyday topics and cultural ideas. It aims to provide you with opportunities to acquire and to try out the relevant language to talk about these ideas. Plus it will help you to develop your understanding of grammatical concepts for more effective communication, such as comparisons, the perfect, subjunctive II.

COURSE FORMAT & DELIVERY

Format: Six week conversation course: 6 x 90 minutes live sessions on Zoom

Material: All course materials are included in the course fee.

Language: Languages of instruction are German and English

Class size: 4-8 students

The course requires a minimum number of 4 persons to run. If this number is not met, we will endeavour to offer you a suitable alternative.

Delivery: The course classes run on Zoom. You will receive the Zoom link upon booking the course.
