Who is the course for?

This conversation course is for intermediate learners of German, which is equivalent to the second level (B1) of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Level B1 means that you can understand and comment on general texts on a variety of topics.

What will you learn?

This conversation course aims to give you an insight into how German speakers discuss current and cultural subjects. Topics covered in previous classes include Nach dem Mauerfall kam die Kunst, Schweizer Käse – jetzt auch vegan, Als erste schwarze Frau in den Bundestag: Awet Tesfaiesus.

The course aims to provide you with opportunities to acquire and to try out the relevant language to talk about these issues. Plus it will help you to develop your understanding of grammatical concepts for more effective communication, such as prefixes, the passive or indefinite pronouns.

COURSE FORMAT & DELIVERY

Format: Six week conversation course: 6 x 90 minutes live sessions on Zoom

Material: All course materials are included in the course fee.

Language: Languages of instruction are German and English

Class size: 4-8 students

The course requires a minimum number of 4 persons to run. If this number is not met, we will endeavour to offer you a suitable alternative.

Delivery: The course classes run on Zoom. You will receive the Zoom link upon booking the course.
